# K. Peter Etzkorn Scholarship

The [Peter Etzkorn Scholarship](#) offers qualified students a one year non-renewable \$1500 grant for study in Stuttgart or Karlsruhe. Professor Dr. Etzkorn was a board member of St. Louis-Stuttgart Sister Cities for 20 years and active in the German American Heritage Society, a former member of the Board of Directors of Sister Cities International, and an honorary member for many years. He taught at several universities before coming to the University of Missouri-St. Louis in 1969 where he was hired as a department chairman and professor of sociology and anthropology. He taught sociology at the university for 33 years and also was associate dean of the graduate school and director of research. He retired in 2000 and passed away in 2002. In 1984, he was awarded the Order of Merit, First Class of West Germany. The scholarship recognizes his effort to promote exchanges between St. Louis and Stuttgart and international students at every level.
